Measures used to determine the amount of the subsidy will depend on the amount past due.

Eligibility Criteria

- Be physically located and operating in the City of Fresno
- Must have been impacted by COVID-19 after March 3, 2021
- Be in good standing with the City of Fresno.
- Must have 10 or less employees

Priority will be given to minority small owned businesses operating in the City of Fresno.

REQUIRED DOCUMENTATION UPON ELIGIBILITY

- Current Lease Agreement
- Active Business License
- Eviction Notice after March 3, 2021
- Power Shut-off Notice after March 3, 2021
- Past due bills and receipts after March 3, 2021

Grants are on a first come, first serve basis until all funds have been exhausted.
